

REINFORCE EUROPEANS DIGITAL, LITERACY AND NUMERACY SKILLS

BASELINE TEST (IO2)

The RED Baseline test is an online tool that allows local organisations - such as the municipality, social services, HR departments of companies/sheltered workshops etc. - to trace quickly and easily people who might have a difficulty with regards to literacy or numeracy or digital skills. The test will not determine the exact level, but will display and give an indication if the person may have a deficiency in that subject.

The RED Baseline test consists of a few reading tasks, math assignments and digital too. It is available in English, Dutch, French, Slovenian, Czech, Bulgarian, Spanish and Italian. Many people struggling low literacy or low numeracy will be detected via these tests and will be re-directed to the platform to find suitable information regarding their individual needs.

Numbers: there will be collected results from 2.000 survey per country (7 partner countries) for a total of 14.000 persons among the EU will undergo this test.

Time: 14 months

ROADMAP: WORK IN PROGRESS

The RED Roadmap is a navigator where all social institutions that could offer help, information or more towards the target group are categorically classified including all contact information. Every partner investigate all social, public, health services and more applicable and connected to the target group. Differing from f.e. information of organisations that offer linguistic course providers in their area, to intakes of the social welfare organisation in their region etc. At the end we will have a regional Roadmap - one for every country - with all contact and background information of linguistic course providers, municipality, social services and other organizations applicable for this target group.

The RED Roadmap will help the person of the target group to express a detailed request for help and find a suitable help provider in their region, which are categorically classified on the RED platform where their contact information can be found.

Numbers: a minimum of 1.500 people per country will use the roadmap and get in touch with the regional organizations for additional help in the partner countries, so in total 10.500 persons (x 7 countries) have the option to better express/search for their request for help and find a suitable help provider in their region.

Time: 12 months
